Lesbian: Lesbian is the term used to describe the sexual orientation for a woman who is emotionally, physically or sexually attracted to other women.

Celebrity Highlight: JoJo Siwa is a popular singer, dancer and YouTube personality who first became famous from her appearance on "Dance Moms' and her vibrant personality and signature bows. Until recently, she was known for her bright, colourful style, but at the start of 2024, she rebranded, adopting a darker aesthetic and describing herself as a "bad girl." In January 2021, JoJo publicly came out as a member of the LGBTQ+ community and later confirmed she identifies as a lesbian. Her openness about her sexuality has inspired many young fans, promoting acceptance and understanding. JoJo uses her platform to advocate for LGBTQ+ rights and inclusivity, remaining a positive role model for her fans.
