HOW TO USE THE PUBLIC BUS - Do you plan to catch the bus to school this year? Bus fares are free for children aged from 5 to 12 with a registered Bee Card, and \$1.20 for 13 to 18-year-olds, for a single trip. You will need to top up your Bee Card. If you haven't caught a bus before, check out information at <u>www.orc.govt.nz/bus101</u> It's a good idea to look at the bus timetables in advance and plan your route. Paying for your bus fare: You can only use a Bee Card or cash to pay for your bus fare. Bank and credit cards cannot be used on buses to pay for a bus fare. Note that Bee Cards can be purchased for \$5 with a minimum \$5 top up, either at <u>www.beecard.co.nz</u> or at a Bee Card retailer.
